4) *Zohar* 2:148b-149a (Daniel Matt translation)

Rabbi Yehudah said, “If [God’s Light] were completely hidden, the world would not exist for even one moment! Rather, it was hidden and sown like a seed that generates offspring and fruit, and by which the world is sustained. There is not a day without something emerging from it into the world and sustaining all, and by this the blessed Holy One feeds the world. And everywhere that Torah is studied at night, one ray issues from that hidden light and is drawn upon those absorbed in her, as is written: *By day YHVH ordains His love, and in the night His song is with me* (Psalms 42:9), as we have established.

“On the day when the Mishkan (the Tabernacle) was made, what is written? *Moses could not come into the Tent of Meeting, for the cloud had settled upon it* (Exodus 40:35). What is the cloud? It was one from the side of primordial light, issuing in the joy of the Bride as She entered the Dwelling below. Since the first day, it has not been revealed; but it certainly does perform in the world, renewing every day the act of Creation!”
